

Special Education Assistant

A full-time Special Education Assistant (SEA) is required to work with an 11 year old female (Gr. 6) with hemihypertrophy resulting in global developmental delay. The selected candidate will work in a classroom setting with the classroom teacher. This position will be to teach the student goals across all areas of life; including education, sports, and lifestyle skills - all from an existing program (IEP).

Candidates should lead Christ centered lives and attend church regularly.

Essential Functions:

1. Provide direct instructional support to the student and monitor the student's ability to follow directions as outlined in the IEP
2. Attend designated classes and activities with the student
3. Reinforce proper behaviours and provide the student with opportunities to practice these
4. Implement modifications and adaptations to the environment or materials as outlined in the IEP
5. Model appropriate pro-social skills, participation, adult behaviours and problem solving skills
6. Act as a cooperative team member in working with staff, community, and families of students

Qualifications:

1. Post secondary diploma in special education or similar
2. Experience working with developmental disabilities relatable to an 11 year old girl an asset
3. Candidates are required to be motivated, reliable, enthusiastic, and possess excellent communication skills
